

Parent Code of Conduct

Our policy can be summed up in one word; RESPECT.

All Parents and Guardians of the North Bay Bulldogs Football players are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that demonstrates respect for players, referees, coaches, fans, property and the game of football.

There will be zero tolerance on the part of the North Bay Bulldogs in regard to parent conduct. Any behavior or actions that constitute what the North Bay Bulldogs Executive deems as abuse of players, coaches, referees, opposing fans or property will not be condoned in any form.

The Head Coach at his sole discretion may take whatever action appropriate on a case by case basis. Discipline may include suspending the offending parent and the parent's player(s) for a duration that the Head Coach deems appropriate. The parent or guardian is NOT entitled to a warning or first offence. In the event that the incident results in an expulsion, no refund of registration fees will be issued by the North Bay Bulldogs Football Club. There will be no appeal process for the offending parent in such case.

The offending parent must return his/her players equipment within 14 days of being notified of their expulsion from the Team. All Team equipment must be returned in good condition. In the event that the Team equipment is not returned within the 14 days, the Team will issue an invoice in the amount of \$300.00 to the offending parent/family.

Unless having obtained permission from the Head Coach, a parent is NOT permitted on the practice or playing field or player's bench area.

Parents are to have no contact with coaches during game time except for cases of emergency.

Should a parent have a concern with regard to a coach, that concern must be brought to the attention of the North Bay Bulldogs Governor's Christa Morgan or Trevor Poulin. If the concern is valid, the Governor will bring the matter before the coach directly. Parents will not bring concerns directly to the coach unless permission has been granted in writing (email) by the Governor.

North Bay Bulldogs Football is a grassroots program supported by the generous donation of time by our volunteers.
